Kamloops Airport announces that additional security measures have been invoked for all commercial passenger aircraft departing from Kamloops. Effective immediately passengers must not carry any liquid or gel products in their carry-on baggage or on their person. There are certain exclusions and they include:

- Baby formula, breast milk, or juice if a baby or small child is traveling
- Prescription medicine with a name that matches the passenger's ticket
- Insulin and essential or other non-prescription medicines

People traveling today and in the coming days can expect some delays at the screening checkpoints as this new restriction becomes more commonly known.
